Are You Living Sincere?

The young man – tall, strong, with a lush black beard and lion's hair – stood tall. He opened his mouth and released his tongue. It did not speak soft, flowery words; but rather it uttered insults, obscenities, and bravado. "Just give me the death penalty!" He screamed. "Send me to the gas chamber! Dictate your sentence! What does it matter to me? I laugh at you, your court, and your jury. "

Judge Gregory Martin, as he was playing, dropped the hammer and applied the death penalty to José Cornell to be convicted of murder. In pronouncing the sentence, he quoted a biblical text by the wise Solomon: "How long, you insolent ones, will be pleased with your insolence?" (Proverbs 1:22).

That individual, sentenced to death for the brutal murder of his life partner, did not care that the person he was mocking had the authority to give or take life. Laughing, mocking in a moment as serious as this, after having committed a murder, is not only a demonstration of extreme insensitivity but also a total disregard for responsibility as a human being. "If you apply the death penalty to me," he had told the judge, "I will laugh in your own face."

There are many who behave like that young man. Not that they make fun of a human judge, but they live making fun of the Supreme Judge. They do not consider that they are making fun of the only One who can give and take life, and who also has the power to cast their soul into hell. How many people live in total contempt for God? How many are there who disregard their moral laws? How many insolent people live trampling on their sacred principles of life and conduct?

What should be our attitude before divine authority? We must, in repentance and humility, make a serene balance of all the activities of our past life, and take well into account the way we are currently living. We must then, in humility and contrition, ask God for forgiveness for everything we have done that has caused Him displeasure as our Creator. Then we must ask His Son Jesus Christ to enter our life as Savior, Owner and Lord. He will give us His forgiveness if we ask for it. It is enough that we open our hearts to Him.
