ABOUT MONEY
Josue Ramirez

From childhood to adulthood, our relationship with money changes. Little children love money because it's shiny. Teenagers want money to impress others or buy what parents won't. And many adults—if we're honest—still feel a strong pull toward it. But here's the plain truth: money itself is not moral or immoral. It's simply a tool. What matters is our attitude toward it.

To help us keep a godly perspective, here are six truths about money every Christian should remember: **Money Cannot Buy Love.** The Beatles sang it decades ago, and it's still true: *"Money can't buy me love."* Money may impress people, but it cannot produce genuine affection, loyalty, or commitment. Young people especially need this reminder. **Money Doesn't Grow on Trees.** Most of us heard this growing up—and it's true. Because money is limited, God calls us to be faithful stewards (1 Corinthians 4:2). We must avoid debt we cannot repay: *"Owe no man anything"* (Romans 13:8). Credit cards should never become chains around our lives. **Money Is Not the Root of All Evil—But the Love of Money Is.** Scripture is clear: *"The love of money is the root of all kinds of evil"* (1 Timothy 6:10). Covetousness is idolatry (Colossians 3:5). A heart obsessed with riches has destroyed friendships, marriages, and even congregations. **Money Cannot Save a Soul.** Money can support preaching (2 Corinthians 11:8–9) and help edify the church, but it cannot redeem anyone. Only the gospel saves. **Money Will Not Follow You Into Eternity.** No matter how much we accumulate, it stays behind. *"We brought nothing into this world, and it is certain we can carry nothing out"* (1 Timothy 6:7). Earthly wealth is temporary; heavenly treasure is eternal. **Money Is Not Success—and Success Is Not Money.** Some wealthy people will be lost. Some poor people will be saved. Financial status does not determine eternal destiny.

True success is defined by God Himself: *"This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth... for then thou shalt make thy way prosperous, and then thou shalt have good success"* (Joshua 1:8). Success is obedience. Success is faithfulness. Success is walking with God.

Jesus cautioned us about *"the deceitfulness of riches"* (Mark 4:19). Money promises more than it can deliver. Let us resolve to see money clearly, use it wisely, and never let it rule our hearts.
