Time to... UPDATE

"Ask for the old paths, where is the good way, and walk therein, and ye shall find rest for your souls." Jeremiah 6:16. We live in a world where everything changes fast. What is "new" today becomes "old" tomorrow. Technology becomes outdated almost as soon as it arrives. Trends fade. Headlines shift. Opinions evolve. But truth never changes. The gospel reads the same today as it did yesterday, and as it will tomorrow. It is *"once for all delivered to the saints"* (Jude 3). Those who try to change it are *"accursed"* (Galatians 1:6-9), and will meet it unchanged at judgment (Revelation 20:12). Yet modern culture insists it has "outgrown" the ancient gospel. Absolute truth is considered obsolete. Sin is dismissed. Spiritual death is ignored. The virgin birth, the sinless life, the sacrificial death, and the resurrection of Jesus are treated as myths. So we ask the question:

WHEN WILL MAN OUTGROW THE GOSPEL? When Man Overcomes Sin — But He Has Not. Sin is still in business. *"All have sinned and come short of the glory of God"* (Romans 3:23). Sin is still the transgression of God's law (1 John 3:4). It includes violating conscience (Romans 14:23), neglecting duty (James 4:17), and *"all unrighteousness"* (1 John 5:17). Peter lists five "germs" that infect the soul (1 Peter 2:1): Malice — bitterness and hidden anger. Guile — deceit and trickery. Hypocrisy — pretending to be what we are not. Envy — resenting the good others receive. Evil speaking — slander and unkind words. Look around: workplace, media, politics, entertainment. Sin is everywhere. Forgiveness is still humanity's greatest need (Romans 3:23; 6:23). And only the gospel can provide it (Romans 1:16).

When Man Conquers Temptation — But He Has Not. The gospel gives power to overcome temptation (Ephesians 6:17). But humans still fall to the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life (1 John 2:15-17). We cannot defeat temptation without the Word (Hebrews 4:12). Even Jesus fought temptation with *"It is written"* (Matthew 4:1-11).

When Man's Soul No Longer Needs Food — But It Still Does. Physically, the average person consumes: 50 heads of cattle. 2,400 chickens. 310 pigs. 26 acres of grain. 50 acres of fruits and vegetables. But none of that feeds the soul. Only the Word of God satisfies spiritual hunger (Matthew 5:6). Peter urges us to crave the *"sincere milk of the word"* (1 Peter 2:2-3). Scripture is water (Revelation 21:6), honey (Psalm 119:103), and milk (Hebrews 5:12-14). Many Christians feed their bodies daily... but feed their souls only on Sundays. No wonder spiritual weakness is common. We must feast on the Word every day (Acts 17:11).

When Man No Longer Needs a Map to Heaven — But He Still Does. Humanity keeps inventing new "paths" to heaven (Ecclesiastes 7:29). Jesus warned against replacing God's commands with human traditions (Mark 7:8-9). False paths abound: "Faith only", "Self-righteousness", "Direct operation of the Spirit", "Once saved, always saved". But Jesus said the road to life is narrow (Matthew 7:13-14). Only the gospel leads home.

When Satan Is Defeated — But He Is Not. The devil is still a roaring lion (1 Peter 5:8). We still need God's armor (Ephesians 6:13-17). No one can defeat Satan without Scripture — not even Jesus (Matthew 4:1-11).

"The word of the Lord endures forever." 1 Peter 1:25. Truth does not age. Truth does not expire. Truth does not evolve. The ancient gospel is still the only path to heaven (John 14:6). We can choose to heed it or ignore it, respect it or ridicule it — but it remains our only hope of entering the gates of glory. Let us walk in the old paths, the good way, and find rest for our souls.
